Happy Charter Day, WRAC!!!

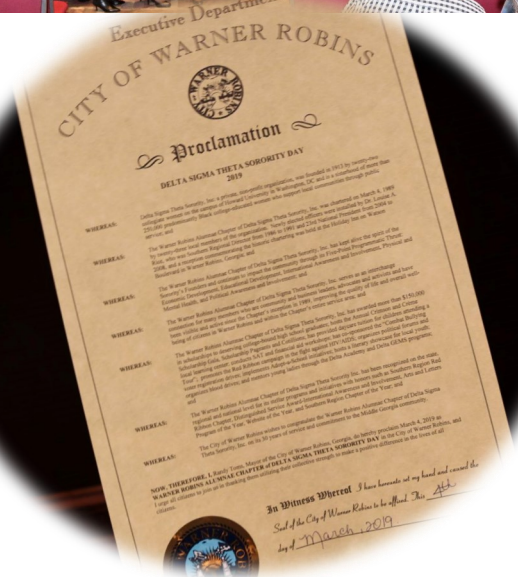

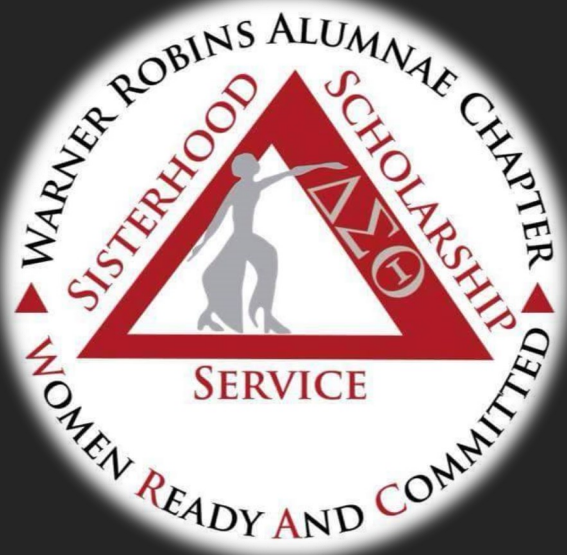
End of the Year Retreat
