CONTEST RULES

- 1. Poems may be read or recited (three-minute limit).
- 2. Each contestant must provide a copy of the poem. Please attach to the entry form. Poems will not be returned. Please keep a copy for yourself. Extra points will be given for original poems. Please indicate on entry form.
- 3. The use of props, music or special costumes is permitted.
- 4. All contestants must state the title and author of the poem before reading or reciting. Please note if it is an original poem.
- 5. Performances will be judged on the following:
 - Poise and eye contact with audience
 - Pronunciation/Enunciation
 - Voice projection

- Dramatic emphasis/expression
 - Poetic interpretation
 - Familiarity with poem
 - Impact on audience
- 6. Poets may write on any topic that is suitable for a general audience. Any poem that does not follow the guidelines will be disqualified.
- 7. Poetry contest **for elementary students** begins at 6:00 p.m. **Elementary contestants** should sign in by 5:30 p.m.
- 8. Poetry contest **for middle and high school students** begins at 7:30 p.m. **Middle and High school contestants** should sign in by 7:05 p.m.
- 9. Contestants will be given a number and will be introduced in the order they sign-in.
